Will Albania have a solar power project?

The Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy of Albania received four applications for solar power projects with a combined capacity of 235 MW. A proposed unit in Fier, the country's photovoltaics hub, would be the second-biggest in the country. Solar power accounts for 6% of electricity production in Albania.

How many MW of solar capacity will Albania have?

The Albanian authorities aim to allocate 300 MW of solar capacity through a new procurement exercise, with projects ranging from 10 MW to 100 MW. Solar Energy of Albania (SENA) aims to develop a 12.9 MW floating solar project on a lake in northwestern Albania, next to an existing hydropower plant.

Will a 100 MW solar power plant be built in Albania?

A company called Euron Solar-PV has submitted an application to the Albanian Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy for the construction of a 100 MW Solar power plant in the villages of Fushe and Povelce, near Fier City. The project is currently in its initial stages and the public has two weeks to submit comments and objections.

Where is Albania's second largest photovoltaic plant?

The company laid the cornerstone late last year for the 100 MW solar power system in the west of Albania. The site is near the port city of Durrës. One other PV plant is planned for expansion to 100 MW. Now another project of the same size is racing for the position of the country's second-largest photovoltaic facility.
