Applications for wind energy, and solar energy, and gen-tie projects may be processed and authorized as rights-of-way under Title V of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976, as amended, ...

All solar and wind energy projects on federal lands and waters must be personally approved by Interior Secretary Doug Burgum.
