Almost three-quarters of all solar and wind power projects being built globally are in China, says a new report that highlights the country's rapid expansion of renewable energy sources.

China has been installing solar panels far faster than anywhere else in the world, and the investment is starting to pay off.

China is showing signs of a shift toward more utility-scale solar in suitable regions, and it is making substantial progress in deploying massive volumes of solar capacity, but powerful ...

The increased power capacity would mark a major milestone in the country's long-standing effort to build a cleaner power system.

China's solar energy production is reaching simply staggering levels, dragging energy costs down around the globe.

Coal plants run closer to their maximum than wind or solar plants. So while coal capacity now trails renewable capacity, coal still accounts for about half of all power produced in China.
