Does a battery room cover maintenance free or computer room type batteries?

It does not cover maintenance free or computer room type batteries and battery cabinets. Do I need a special battery room?

Valve regulated lead acid (VRLA) batteries and modular battery cartridges (MBC) do not require special battery rooms and are suitable for use in an office environment. Air changes designed for human occupancy normally exceed the requirements for VRLA and MBC ventilation.

Can batteries be installed in a room?

If the room has controlled access (i.e., accessible only by trained and authorized personnel), the batteries can be installed in open racks; otherwise the batteries should be in cabinets with lockable doors. Rooms and cabinets should be designed to prevent the accumulation of hydrogen as described below.

Does a battery room need a ventilation system?

Ventilation systems must address health and safety as well as performance of the battery and other equipment in a room. Valve regulated lead acid (VRLA) batteries and modular battery cartridges (MBC) do not require special battery rooms and are suitable for use in an office environment.

Because cabinets can have locked doors, the cabinets do not have to be in battery rooms; they can be installed directly adjacent to the UPS system and/or the information technology equipment.

For optimal battery performance, battery room HVAC systems should be designed to maintain a uniform average ambient room temperature of 77°F. Battery room temperatures below 77°F increase ...
