A fire in a wind turbine that sent smoke billowing over Mid North South Australia has sparked worries that such a blaze could result in a bushfire on a hotter and windier day.

Wind energy's hidden hazard Wind power is a cornerstone of the global energy transition, but towering turbines are not without risk. Fire incidents, though infrequent, can lead to catastrophic ...

Fires are the second most common type of accident within wind turbines, representing a significant threat to wind turbines.

A wind turbine caught fire, leading to a grass fire beneath it. Fortunately, there were no injuries, but the incident resulted in an estimated \$2.2 million in damages.

We have found that fire is the second leading cause of catastrophic accidents in wind turbines (after blade failure) and accounts for 10 to 30% of the reported turbine accidents of any year since 1980's.
