Why did SolarEdge lay off 400 employees?

SolarEdge Technologies said on Monday it would lay off 400 employees globally, its fourth job-cut announcement in the past 12 months as the U.S.-based solar inverter maker grapples with an industry-wide downturn.

How much will SolarEdge's layoffs cost the company?

SolarEdge (SEDG) said it expects to record \$3M-\$5M in charges related to the layoffs, mostly to be recognized in Q1 2025; once the workforce reductions are completed, the company anticipates a quarterly reduction in expenses of \$9M-\$11M.

Is Enphase Energy laying off workers?

A view of Enphase Energy equipment. The Fremont-based company announced layoffs last week in a new filing. Enphase Energy, a Fremont-based solar technology and electric vehicle charger company, is laying off about 500 workers.

Will Enphase keep its microinverter manufacturing stable?

Enphase wrote that it will keep its total microinverter manufacturing stable -- microinverter devices transform the electrical current generated by solar panels into usable electricity for homes, businesses and the wider grid. The company's website says it surpassed 73 million microinverters shipped in 2024.

U.S. photovoltaic inverter manufacturer SolarEdge announced on Monday that it will lay off 400 employees globally in response to the sluggishness of the entire industry.
