When the doors are left closed, the food inside a standard refrigerator should stay cold for approximately 4 hours. If the power outage lasts longer than this, move the refrigerator's milk,...

In case of a power outage, the appliance thermometers will indicate the temperatures in the refrigerator and freezer to help you determine if the food is safe. Freeze containers of water for...

Make sure there is enough ice to keep food in the cooler at 40 °F (4.4 °C) or below. Add more ice to the cooler as it begins to melt. A full freezer will hold the temperature for approximately ...

The general consensus is that a refrigerator can maintain a safe temperature for up to 4 hours during a power outage, while a full freezer can keep foods frozen for approximately 48 hours if ...

If the power is out beyond four hours, you can still eat the food in the fridge for up to another two hours -- provided the internal refrigerator temp is in the safe zone (35 to 38°F).

The clock starts ticking on your refrigerated food when the power goes out, says Czerwony. In general, you can expect a closed refrigerator to keep food safe for about four hours ...

If the doors stay closed, food will stay safe up to: 4 hours in a refrigerator, 48 hours in a full freezer, 24 hours in a half-full freezer. If the power has been out for 4 hours, and a cooler and ice ...

You need to keep food cold if you lose electrical power. The No. 1 rule if the power goes out is to keep the fridge or freezer door closed to keep the cold air inside.
