Keep Holes Sealed: Since solar panel installation requires drilling holes in the roof, any penetration can cause leaks. Apply industrial-grade sealant to the hardware.

In virtually all cases, the answer is no. Roof leaks after solar panels are extremely rare. When roof leaking after the solar panels are fitted does occur, however, it usually becomes evident ...
